As members of the 2020 Arctic Winter Games Arctic Sports/Dene Games team; you, as a player, are the most visible part of the team. All members are ambassadors for the team, the sport, and the Northwest Territories. You gain many benefits from your participation in an organized program. Your participation brings with it some responsibilities. These responsibilities include the following:

- 1. At all times be courteous and helpful to teammates, coaches, managers, other players, officials and the general public.
- 2. Participate according to the rules and in the spirit of fair play.
- 3. To not partake in alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or drug use at any time. This includes vaping.
- 4. Be punctual at all times. Attend all tournaments, camps, and practices organized by your coach. Notify Coaches if you are unable to attend or be late to any events. If you're unable to attend you must notify your coach before hand.
- 5. Remain at competitions for award presentations, banquets and other events unless previous arrangements have been made.
- 6. Be passing all High School classes, as well as maintain a 75% attendance record, unless medical or personal reasons occur. Attendance will be reviewed on a monthly basis.
- 7. Must complete any training programs outlined by the Head Coach.

Athletes unable to comply with these responsibilities may be subject to disciplinary action that may include removal from the team.
